

Data protection information pursuant to Art. 13 GDPR

With the following data protection information we, the Leibniz-Institut für Festkörper- und Werkstoffforschung Dresden e. V. (IFW) [Leibniz Institute for Solid State and Materials Research Dresden reg. association], as the data controller within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), explain which personal data we process, when you visit our library website and use our online library services.

We reserve the right to occasionally adjust our data protection information so that it always complies with the current legal requirements or in order to present changes to our services. Therefore, we recommend you read the data protection information regularly in order to remain up to date regarding the protection of the personal data processed by us.

2. Data processing

Recording and creation of log files

A host of technical data is recorded while accessing <https://ifwlib.bibliotheca-open.de/>. These general data and information are stored in the log files of the server. Your IP address, referrer URL, your browser identification and domain, the name of the called file, date and time of the call, the data volume transferred as well as the successful call are recorded in a protocol file. The personal data are processed in order to make the website available as well as for error correction and investigation of misuse - or acts of fraud owing to a legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. f GDPR. The log files will be erased after seven days.

Cookies

Owing to a legitimate interest according to Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. f GDPR exclusively technically necessary cookies are used in case of an access to <https://ifwlib.bibliotheca-open.de/>. The legitimate interest of the IFW is guaranteeing the user-friendliness (e.g. cross-site registration of registered users or the language selection) as well as an unlimited technical functionality of the website (e.g. terminal device compatibility). The storage duration of these cookies is a maximum of 70 days.

Interlibrary loan

For purposes of loan traffic respectively the acquisition of literature that is not available at your request as well as the necessary correspondence with you, e.g. with the notification of the processing status, we process your contact data (first name, last name, email address) as well as possible literature preferences on the basis

of Art. Para. 1 lit. b GDPR. Recipients of the data are the responsible employees of the IFW. Your data will be erased after a completed order process if the erasure is not opposed by statutory storage deadlines.

We use Google Fonts for the standard presentation of the types of writing in different browsers of our website visitors and for the technically secure, low-maintenance and efficient use of fonts, as well as by taking possible restrictions under licensing law for their integration into consideration. The legal basis is our legitimate interest according to Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. f GDPR. The files (CSS, Fonts) are requested via the Google domains fonts.googleapis.com and fonts.gstatic.com. According to Google the requests for fonts are carried out separately from all other Google services. According to its own information Google only limits itself to making fonts available and, according to its own information, only assesses the data of the visitors in an aggregated form. i.e., the total of all data is only used in order to create statistics (e.g. which font is used and how often). For this purpose, usage data (e.g. interest in contents) as well as metadata and communication data (e.g. device information and IP addresses), are processed in an aggregated form according to the information of Google.

Use of service providers for the provision of the website

We use service providers in order to provide the website, which process personal data by order of the IFW or through which an access to personal data cannot be excluded. We have concluded contracts with these service providers for the data processing according to Art. 28 GDPR. Besides the already named service providers it concerns OCLC GmbH (hosting/support).

3. References to rights of data subjects and contact to the data protection officer

Affected people can request information at all times regarding the personal data relating to them and, if applicable, rectification or erasure respectively limitation of the processing or object to processing. In addition, there is a right to data portability for their benefit. In addition, insofar as the data processing is carried out based on a consent, this consent can be revoked for the future at all times.
